

ANIMAL POLICY

Non-service animals and pets are not permitted within the Exhibition Hall or West Village Dining Commons. Service animals are defined as those animals that are individually trained to do work or perform task for the benefit of a differentially abled person or persons. The service animal must be under the control of its handler at all times.

Pet Therapy

Exhibition Hall and West Village Dining Commons event spaces may be reserved for the purpose of pet therapy. In accordance with the <u>Georgia Tech Policy</u> for animal exhibits, generally only non-dangerous, mature domestic animals with the required documentation are permitted.

Provider of the animals must provide the following to Georgia Tech Insurance & Claims Management:

- Documented proof that all animals have had their required shots including but not limited to vaccinations, such shots are up to date, and the animals are free of rabies.
- Evidence of liability insurance coverage.
